#### CHARLES COOPER

Charles Cooper has exhibited since 1974 in solo and group shows at public galleries, including Ivan Dougherty, the Museum of Sydney, Macquarie University, Tin Sheds, the Art Gallery of NSW (Sulman, Wynne and Dobell finalists) and Grace Cossington-Smith, as well as eighteen regional galleries in NSW, Victoria and Queensland (solo 1988-89 and 2010) and private galleries such as Macquarie, Bloomfield, Garry Anderson, Stephen Mori and Annandale in Sydney, Murray Crescent in Canberra. His work has been in group shows in Melbourne, Adelaide, Canberra, Monaco, Cambridge, New York, Rome, Beijing and Shanghai.

He was awarded the Hunter's Hill Art Prize 1978, an Australia Council CEAD Grant 1996, AGNSW Trustees' Watercolour Prize 1998 and the Adelaide Perry Prize for Drawing 2020.

Residencies include Canberra School of Art 2005, Cite des Arts Paris 2006, Penrith Regional Gallery 2007 and the British School at Rome 2012.

His work is in a dozen regional and university collections in NSW and Victoria.

Between 1993 and 2023 he taught painting and drawing in Sydney at the University of Western Sydney, Sydney College of the Arts, UNSW College of Fine Arts and, most recently, the National Art School..

A monograph on his work by Joe Frost, <u>Charles Cooper On Location</u>, was published in 2022.
